## D8.2 Interface to external repositories.

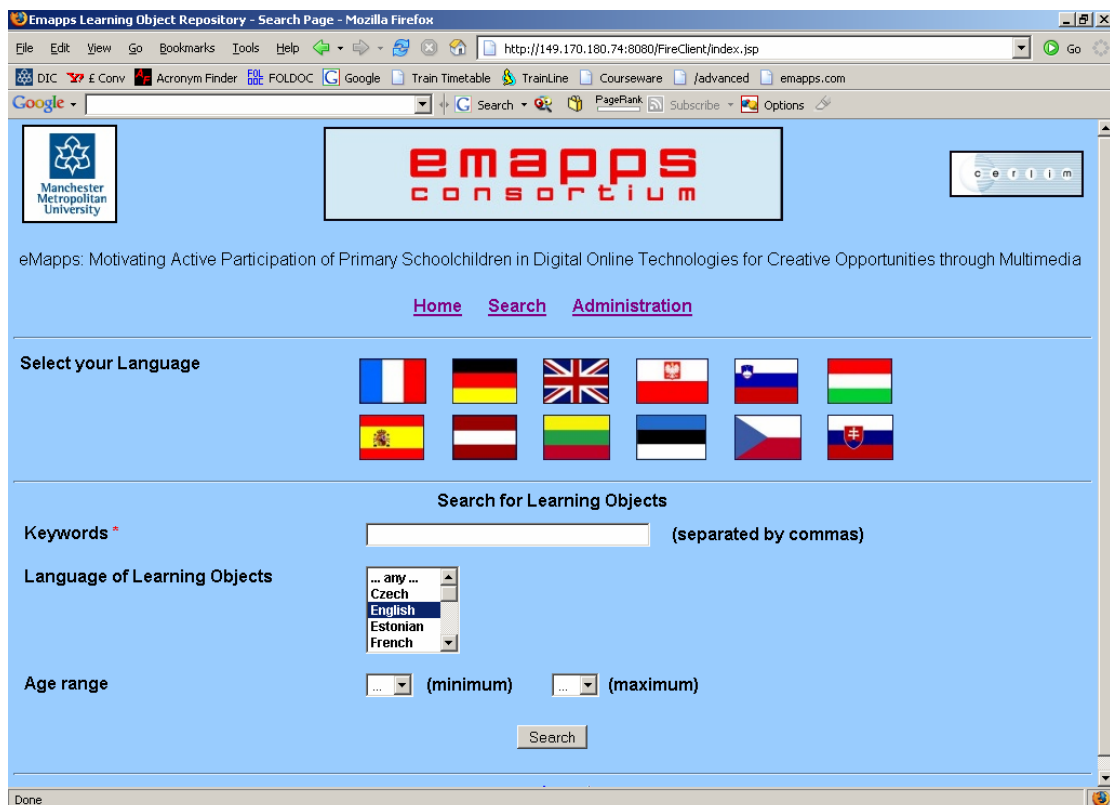
The creation of games in the eMapps.com project involves assembling digital materials into games. These materials can be obtained either by creating new materials (e.g., a picture taken by a teacher or pupil with a digital camera), or by reusing existing ones (e.g., a music record available on line, a learning resource in a specialised repository).

Using EUN's Federation of Internet Resources for Education (FIRE), the eMapps *Interface to external repositories* provides access to specialised repositories of learning resources and learning objects by connecting to the EUN Learning Resource Exchange (LRE). This connection will allow eMapps.com users to benefit from the resources available in the repositories participating in the LRE (including repositories in Estonia, Hungary, Lithuania, Poland, and Slovenia), using the resource discovery service of the LRE to retrieve educational resources.
